

ORDER

(To Consider Appointing Truitt Taylor as Ward 5 Representative on the Historic Preservation Commission)

WHEREAS, the Historic Preservation Commission of the City of Laurel was established under the Mississippi Local Government Historic Preservation Act of 1978 (Chapter 472, Laws of Mississippi, 1978); **and**

WHEREAS, the Historic Preservation Commission of the City of Laurel is required to remain in compliance with the aforementioned law under the terms of the certification agreement between the State of Mississippi and the City of Laurel; **and**

WHEREAS, the term of Ryan Hearn, Ward 5 representative on the Historic Preservation Commission for the City of Laurel expired on July 18, 2026, creating a vacancy that must be filled; **and**

WHEREAS, Mr. Truitt Taylor, whose biographical information is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**, has expressed his willingness to serve as the Ward 5 representative for a six-year term

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Laurel City Council upon nomination by Mayor Johnny Magee that Mr. Truitt Taylor be authorized to serve as representative of Ward 5 on the Laurel Historic Preservation Commission. His six-year term is effective immediately and will expire on July 18, 2032
