

FINAL RESOLUTION DENYING EXEMPTION
FROM AD VALOREM TAXES

The City Council of Laurel this day considered the matter of granting exemption from ad valorem taxes, except school district taxes and “mandated municipal levies” to Dunn Roadbuilders, LLC, by its Order dated June 18, 2024.

The governing authority finds that the Department of Revenue has certified that the applicant is ineligible for exemption. The authority finds that the application submitted to the City of Laurel was excluded from being submitted to the County; therefore, resulting in an ineligible application and a denial of the requested amount for tax exemption.

This governing authority does hereby decline to grant ad valorem tax exemption to the above taxpayer for a period of 10 years, beginning January, 2024, and expiring January, 2033 on the property described in the application with a total true value of **\$10,682.00**.

Therefore, the resolution to deny ad valorem tax exemption to the above-named enterprise is hereby approved by City Council of Laurel based on the application not earning the approval of the State, on this the 16th day of July, 2024.
