

EMERGENCY ORDER

(To Authorize the Removal of an Obstruction in Water Well #6)

WHEREAS, the Administration has been advised by Veolia that Water Well #6, a high producing water well that pumps water to Plant #3, contains an obstruction that needs to be removed in order to maintain adequate water supply for the City (see **Exhibit A**); and


WHEREAS, Veolia has obtained three quotes, (see **Exhibit B**), for the proposed work. Thompson Brothers Drilling quoted an hourly rate, declining to include projections for materials and time; Griner Drilling Service Inc. offered hourly rates for service without estimating time allotment for the work. National Water Services offered a complete quote including an estimated time allotment for the project with an itemized quote in the amount of forty-five thousand seven hundred seventy dollars (\$45,770.00), and Veolia recommends the City accept this estimate.

WHEREAS, failure to make necessary repairs immediately creates a hazard to the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, §31-7-13(k) of the Mississippi Code of 1972 Annotated gives authority to the Mayor, acting as an agent of the City, to order immediate remediation of circumstances which threaten the safety and welfare of the citizens of the city, with ratification of said actions to be granted by the council at the next regularly scheduled meeting

NOW THEREFORE, I, Johnny Magee, Mayor of the City of Laurel, acting under the authority granted by §31-7-13(k) of the Mississippi Code of 1972 Annotated, do hereby order that the City accept the quote from National Water Services in the amount of forty-five thousand seven hundred seventy dollars (\$45,770.00) for the removal of an obstruction from Water Well #6, and authorize National Water Services to begin work immediately. **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED**, that the Finance Director be authorized to make any budget transactions necessary for the implementation of the forgoing order.

Terry came by this morning and talked with Mayor Magee about the attached quotes for Well work.

Well #6 is a high producing water well that pumps water to Plant #3. This well has an obstruction in the well that needs to be fished out for the well to be back operational.

Thompson Brothers and Griner Drilling both quoted their hourly rates and would not give a hard quote for the Work. In the past, we have had both Thompson and Griner complete work for us similar but were

unsuccessful at completing.

NWS quoted the job in full which would be my recommendation.

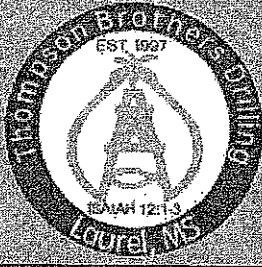
