

RESOLUTION

(Authorizing Removal of Liens from Tax Assessments Against Certain Properties)

WHEREAS, certain properties have been assessed taxes for demolition and cleaning by the City of Laurel under the regulations of Section 21-19-11, as Amended, MS Code of 1972, and the Standard Unsafe Building Abatement Code, 1985; and

WHEREAS, due to a clerical error, assessments to certain properties were made in duplicate and assessments to certain properties were not noted in the record when the property was purchased therefore requiring removal of the assessments

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by City of Laurel as follows:

PPIN – 16202, also known as 2023 Ellisville Blvd,
2024 taxes due from lot cleaning assessment in the amount of \$8,329.89 be removed

PPIN – 16203, also known as 2027 Ellisville Blvd,
2024 taxes due from lot cleaning assessment in the amount of \$7,143.67 be removed

PPIN – 16204, also known as 2033 Ellisville Blvd.
2025 taxes due from lot cleaning assessment in the amount of \$5,075.00 be removed

PPIN- 12440, also known as 1707 S. 11th Avenue,
2023 taxes due from lot cleaning assessment in the amount of \$5,901.00 be vacated

PPIN – 14448, also known as 911 S. 14th Avenue,
2023 taxes due from lot cleaning assessment in the amount of \$5,101.00 be vacated

PPIN – 13305, also known as 2322 Queensburg Avenue,
2023 taxes due from lot cleaning assessment in the amount of \$5,551.00 be vacated

PPIN – 10112, also known as 1028 N 4th Avenue,
in 2024 Judith Hughes made double payment of taxes and should be reimbursed in the amount of \$5,101.00

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Laurel City Council is in agreement that the tax sales for PPIN 16202 and PPIN 16203 be vacated and tax sales for 2023 for PPIN 12440, PPIN 14448, and PPIN 13305 be vacated.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Finance Director be authorized to make any budgetary actions necessary for implementation of the foregoing Resolution.
