2026 DYB WORLD SERIES HOST AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is made and entered into by and between **DYB INC.** ("**DYB**"), a South Carolina Corporation having its principal office located at 405 West Rusk, Marshall, Texas 75670 **DYB, Inc.** and The City of Laurel 401 North 5th Avenue, Laurel, Mississippi 39440 ("**LAUREL**" or "**Host**").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, **DYB** has awarded **LAUREL** the rights to Host the ten 2026 Diamond Youth Baseball ("**DYB**") World Series for the respective Division I & II A, AA, AAA, Majors, and "O"Zone age divisions.

WHEREAS the requirements for Hosting a DYB World Series have been developed for the purpose of providing a play-off system to determine the number one team in DYB under the most rewarding and pleasant conditions possible, primarily, for the participants of the state championship teams.

WHEREAS the primary consideration in hosting the DYB World Series will always be the welfare and concern for the participating teams.

WHEREAS **LAUREL** agrees to provide services and facilities for events necessary to plan, finance and staff the Division II DYB AAA, Majors, and "O"Zone World Series during the week of July 22-27, 2026.

WHEREAS **LAUREL** agrees to provide services and facilities for events necessary to plan, finance and staff the Division I & II AA Division 8U DYB World Series during the week of July 22-27, 2026.

WHEREAS **LAUREL** agrees to provide services and facilities for events necessary to plan, finance and staff the Division I DYB AAA, Majors, and "O"Zone World Series during the week of July 29-August 3, 2026

WHEREAS **LAUREL** agrees to provide services and facilities for events necessary to plan, finance and staff the Division I & II A Division 6U DYB World Series during the week of July 29-August 3, 2026

WHEREAS **LAUREL** agrees to provide such services and facilities to **DYB** upon the terms and conditions set forth herein.

WHEREAS **LAUREL** may voluntarily provide additional hospitality and services which exceed the provisions of this agreement.

THEREFORE, **LAUREL** agrees to the fulfill the following terms, conditions, and provisions:

I. TEAM MEALS

LAUREL will not be responsible for providing team meals for each team participating in these World Series except for the team meal provided by **LAUREL** prior to Opening Ceremonies. **LAUREL** will provide a listing of area restaurants appropriate for team use with addresses, phone numbers, and a map (if possible) to include in the Commissioner's State Champion World Series information packets to the teams and in any Team Welcome packets distributed by the Host.

LAUREL will:

- a) Provide a team meal for all teams prior to Opening Ceremonies on the day preceding the first day of World Series play on July 22, 2026 and July 30, 2026, for the DYB World Series at 5:00 pm at the **Magnolia Center 1457 Ellisville Blvd, Laurel, MS 39440**
- b) Provide a listing of area restaurants appropriate for team use with addresses, phone numbers, and a map (if possible) in the Team Welcome Packets.

II. TEAM HOUSING

Each team participating in these World Series is responsible for securing its own housing accommodations.

III. SUNDAY TEAM WORSHIP SERVICE

LAUREL shall provide a 35–45-minute Sunday worship services to be held on July 26, 2026, and August 2, 2026, for the participating teams. The service will be held at 9:30 am at **TBA** (weather dependent). Preferably, this service shall be exclusively for the teams, parents, fans, and DYB officials. The church service shall be oriented toward the age of the players. The time and place of the service should be set according to the team's housing locations and conclude by noon. The planned worship service shall be reviewed and approved by the Commissioner.

IV. OFFICIALS HOUSING & MEETING FACILITIES

DYB World Series - (July 22- August 3, 2026)

(a) DYB will contract with a local hotel that will be used exclusively as a headquarters facility near all DYB World Series activities for housing officers, national board members, state directors, and district directors.

(b) LAUREL will provide a suitable location, approved by the Commissioner, for the DYB World Series Managers Meetings to be held on July 22, 2026, and July 29, 2026. The meetings will be held at the **Magnolia Center 1457 Ellisville Blvd, Laurel, MS 39440**.

V. HOSPITALITY/ENTERTAINMENT

(a) LAUREL shall invite all DYB/DYB Officials (National Directors, State Directors, District Directors, Assistant State Directors, and Assistant District Directors), their spouses and their dependent children to any planned social event for the National Board including entertainment and meals. The President and Commissioner shall be responsible for determining if LAUREL will include additional people to these events and be responsible for controlling access by unauthorized persons.

(b) LAUREL will provide a team meal on July 22, 2026, and July 30, 2026, for all World Series teams, national board members, state directors and their families and any local officials LAUREL wishes to invite on the evening preceding the first day's World Series game. The team meal will be held at a location approved by the Commissioner. The menu should be planned for the likes of the participating players, i.e., hamburgers, chicken, etc. and approved by the Commissioner. The location for the team meal for the teams should be shown on the area map included in the Team Welcome Packet. It is strongly recommended that LAUREL use a minimum of four (4) to six (6) serving lines to serve the meal.

(c) The "Hospitality Area" located at the playing fields provided by the LAUREL for DYB officials and umpires must be offered to their wives and immediate families. The "Hospitality Area" refreshments should include coffee, juice, soft drinks, water, and light snacks. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OF ANY KIND ARE ALLOWED AT ANY FUNCTION OF DYB.** Hospitality areas must be handicap accessible.

(d) **TEAM PARENTS** - The Host will assign adult team parents to each competing team who will provide assistance to their assigned team from the time the team arrives at the World Series until that team departs. Team parents are to be thoroughly familiar with all World Series information and schedules. Team parents should be assigned to each team to provide any assistance needed during the World Series and to be on call by the team manager at all times. Each team should be provided with the name and number of a physician and hospital with which arrangements have been made for treatment.

(e) LAUREL will furnish each team with a listing of other optional entertainment available in the area, such as free admission to local theaters, swimming pools, bowling centers, recreation centers, mini golf courses, etc. Should optional planned events such as tours etc. be provided, teams will be required to register at check-in if they plan to participate. Teams are encouraged, but not required, to participate in optional events.

(f) LAUREL will engage an "Official Photographer" and arrange for photographs taken during the DYB World Series to be displayed at the playing fields and made available for sale to the public.

(g) LAUREL will provide information about reasonable laundry services for all participating teams for game uniforms. Information about the laundry service should be included in the Team Welcome Packet.

VI. AWARDS

(a) LAUREL will pay DYB \$23,100 to defray the costs of all DYB World Series trophies, medallions, champions caps, champions rings, Host team t-shirts, Champion flags, Host team flags, and other awards including any related shipping costs. The Official trophies, caps, rings and awards and the World Series Host team t-shirts and flags will be ordered from approved vendors by DYB and all vendor invoices will be billed directly to DYB. DYB will pay the vendor invoices directly. **See Appendix A for a breakdown of costs to be paid by the Host.**

(b) LAUREL shall pay DYB for host expenses as follows: \$11,550 on or before JANUARY 20, 2026, and \$11,550 on or before APRIL 17, 2026. LAUREL will be invoiced by DYB for these costs. The total costs to LAUREL for the above items will not exceed \$23,100 for all World Series.

(c) LAUREL will be assessed and pay a 10% late fee on any installment payment which is 15 days or more late.

(d) LAUREL will provide adequate, protected, air-conditioned space at the playing facilities for storage of trophies until the appropriate time to be presented. LAUREL will be responsible for replacing any lost or damaged trophies, medallions, champions caps, champions rings, umpire base caps, and other awards at LAUREL's expense.

(e) LAUREL will assist in retrieving home run balls for presentation on the field following the game in which it was hit.

(f) LAUREL will furnish a birthday cake for team members having a birthday during the World Series. The cake should be presented to the player at home plate following his team's game on his birthday or during opening ceremonies if applicable.

(g) LAUREL will provide all participants, including managers/coaches, with a souvenir package upon the team's elimination from the World Series. These packages should contain any type of inexpensive gift/ souvenir or any item that LAUREL wishes to provide.

VII. FINANCIAL REPORT

LAUREL will complete a financial report for the World Series specifying direct and in-kind revenue and expenses in a format specified by the **DYB** Treasurer. **LAUREL** will send to the **DYB** Treasurer and the Commissioner within 30 days of the completion of the Series the complete World Series financial report. This report will be forwarded to the World Series Requirement Chairman.

VIII. WORLD SERIES ADMISSION FEES/ PASSES

(a) Series Admission Fees - **LAUREL** must provide a Series admission pass for \$35 and a game day admission pass for \$12 for World Series games at the Laurel Sports Complex. At each World Series, the Host shall collect an additional \$1 for each game day pass sold for the first two days and an additional \$2 for each tournament pass sold which will be donated by the Host to the **DYB** Scholarship Fund. The admission fees for the Series pass and game day pass must be approved by the Commissioner.

(b) Passes Provided by Host - **HOST** will provide Series passes to members of the press and to:

- 1) Managers and coaches of participating teams.
- 2) The spouses and dependent children of the managers and coaches.
- 3) Umpires, umpire's spouses, and dependent children.

(c) Passes Provided by Commissioner - **LAUREL** will accept passes provided by the Commissioner of **DYB, Inc.** for:

- 1) National Board members and their families.
District Directors and their families, and other invited guests of the national organization; and
- 2) A maximum often (10) passes for group planning to bid on a future World Series.

IX. SOUVENIRS/CONCESSIONS

(a) DYB, Inc. grants **LAUREL** a non-exclusive license to use **DYB's** name and logo and other branding to be used to promote and advertise the **DYB** World Series.

(b) LAUREL can only use **DYB** and/or **Diamond Youth Baseball** for branding purposes including souvenir shirts and merchandise, the World Series program, and all other promotional materials. See **DYB, Inc** **Wordmark Guidelines in Appendix B.**

(c) DYB, Inc. grants **LAUREL** an exclusive license to use the **DYB** World Series name on t-shirts and other souvenir merchandise items for sale during the World Series. **LAUREL** shall retain the rights to all proceeds from its merchandise sales.

(d) DYB, Inc. retains the right to set-up souvenir tents/tables for sale of **non-"World Series"** branded merchandise items for sale during the World Series. **DYB** shall retain the rights to all proceeds for all non-World Series branded items merchandise sales.

(e) LAUREL agrees to provide concession services with reasonable prices for all concession menu items. **LAUREL** will provide concession services at all games during the **DYB** World Series and shall retain the rights to all proceeds from concession sales.

X. PUBLICITY/CEREMONIES

(a) LAUREL will publish an "Official" **DYB** World Series program containing pictures of competing teams in a format approved by the Commissioner and other material of interest in connection with the event. **LAUREL** shall pay the printing costs for the **DYB** World Series programs and may sell the programs to fans attending the World Series at a reasonable amount. **LAUREL** must also include the following pages:

- 1) "What Is **DYB/DYS** "
- 2) Pictures of **DYB** National Board (Multiple Pages)
- 3) Baseball Scholarship Page
- 4) Official World Series Brackets (Multiple Pages)
- 5) Team Pictures w/ **DYB** State Director Picture and rosters on same page
- 6) **DYB** World Series Umpires Page
- 7) Official Ball Ad

(b) DYB will supply a copy for the above pages to the World Series program printer as designated by **LAUREL**. The cover and contents of the World Series program will be sent to the Commissioner for final approval. All team pictures will be sent directly to the **LAUREL** World Series printer or an individual designated by the Host Chairman.

(c) World Series Programs - The "official programs " shall include the **DYB** logo on the front cover. The cover and contents of the "official program" must be approved by the Commissioner. **LAUREL** shall give all **DYB/DYB** board members a complimentary copy of the "official program" and the Commissioner shall be provided an additional supply of 80 "official programs" for promotional purposes.

XI. DISPLAY OF STATE FLAGS

LAUREL will arrange to display the American flag and the flags of each state competing in the World Series. State flags for this purpose will be provided by DYB. Flags will be displayed in center field above the fence as long as each team remains in the World Series. LAUREL's Host flag will be displayed only on the field its Host team is playing on. LAUREL will reimburse DYB for any flags for any flag(s) not returned to DYB.

LAUREL shall follow the following procedures for mounting each state flag on the outfield fences of each field used in World Series games.

(a) DYB will provide 11 state flags for each playing field representing the eleven states participating in each for the DYB World Series. If LAUREL requests the use of more than two fields for any one Series, it shall bear the cost of the additional flag sets for use on these fields.

(b) LAUREL shall provide at their cost one World Series Host flag for each age division.

which shall be mounted on the field on which the LAUREL's Host team is playing in every game played by the LAUREL Host team. At the option and expense of LAUREL, they may purchase two flags and leave them permanently mounted on each field until such time as the team is eliminated from Series play.

(c) LAUREL shall purchase sixty (60) sets of 3/4" diameter pipe either electrical conduit pipe or PVC pipe in ten-foot (10') lengths. One inch from the top of each pipe a hole shall be drilled in the pipe for the purpose of attaching the flag to the pole. Another hole will be drilled where the bottom flag grommet intersects the pipe. Plastic ties shall be used to affix the flags to the poles.

(d) LAUREL shall purchase sixty (60) sets of one-inch (1 ") PVC pipe in 30-inch lengths to insert the pipe attached to the flag in (c) above. A PVC cap shall be affixed to the bottom of each PVC pipe.

(e) Mount the open end of the PVC pipe two inches below the top of the fence on the outside of the field. (This prevents a player from jumping to make a catch and having the PVC pipe hang over the top of the fence when flags were not set in them).

(f) The PVC pipe shall be mounted using radiator clamps placed around a fence post and tightened to the PVC pipe.

(g) When the 3/4" electrical conduit pipe is inserted into the 1" PVC pipe, the flags shall extend approximately 7 ½ feet above the top of the fence.

(h) LAUREL must obtain the approval of the Commissioner to use an alternative method of installation of the flag holders along the outfield fence.

(i) LAUREL will return state flags from each field to a DYB official in the press box after each team is eliminated during the Series.

(j) **World Series Promotion** - LAUREL will provide adequate decorations in its community and at the playing fields, beginning at least two days prior to the opening of the World Series. LAUREL may use street banners and posters advertising the event in store windows and merchants will be encouraged to promote the event during World Series Week.

XII. WORLD SERIES MEDIA

(a) **Trademarks** - "Diamond Youth Baseball" and "Diamond Youth Softball" are registered trademarks of DYB, Inc.

(b) **World Series hosts must obtain written approval from the Commissioner of DYB, Inc.® before using the "Diamond Youth Baseball" or "Diamond Youth Softball" wordmarks. See DYB, Inc Wordmark Guidelines in Appendix B.**

(c) **Media Rights** - DYB, Inc. holds the exclusive media, broadcast, and streaming rights to the Diamond Youth Baseball and Softball World Series tournaments. No commercial recording, transmission, or streaming is permitted without the prior written consent of DYB, Inc.

(d) **Media Coverage** - LAUREL will brief the Commissioner on plans for local newspaper, television and radio coverage and national wire service coverage. LAUREL will request the local news media to give the entire World Series full coverage.

(e) **Internet Coverage - Webcasts Internet Bandwidth** - LAUREL shall provide a segregated, dedicated, and secure internet connection with a minimum upload speed of ten (10) meg for the purpose of providing webcasts of games at each press box.

(f) **Internet Coverage - Press Box** - LAUREL shall provide a segregated, dedicated, and secure internet for updating DYB website, live scoring, and box scores of DYB World Series games. LAUREL should provide a separate internet connection for any public access where possible.

(g) **Media Facilities** - LAUREL will provide adequate facilities for media. Television - If LAUREL secures television coverage for the Series, the Commissioner will approve the location of necessary wiring used by production crews.

(h) **The National Anthem** must be played, and an invocation given at the beginning of each session of play. Proper patriotic and spiritual emphasis must be given to all activities of the World Series Week.

XIII. OPENING CEREMONY

(a) LAUREL will provide an opening ceremony after a team meal for participating teams using a format approved by the Commissioner for all World Series. Included in these ceremonies will be a parade of teams, in uniform, into the park. These ceremonies will be held at 7:00 pm on July 22 and July 30 at the **Magnolia Center 1457 Ellisville Blvd, Laurel, MS 39440.**

(b) No local awards of any type are to be made, and it is urged that only the "necessary" minimum number of politicians be introduced. If a speaker is used, it should be a person of interest to the players and who can make an address directed to those participants. Other strongly recommended events for the Opening Ceremonies should include but not limited to a fireworks or laser show, entertainment from a local band or musical group and interactive entertainment such as a team video, comedian, etc. **Extra emphasis should be placed on the introduction of the teams and players during the Opening Ceremony.** A singer shall sing, or a band shall play the national anthem at the Opening Ceremony.

(c) The DYB National Board, as a group, will be recognized at the opening ceremonies and **LAUREL** will provide reserved seating for the National Board and their families at the opening ceremonies.

(d) Plans for this opening ceremony will be reviewed and approved by the Commissioner. The agenda for the Opening Ceremony will be reviewed periodically with the Commissioner throughout the year preceding the Series. Any major changes shall be approved by the Commissioner. **No alcoholic beverages may be served at opening ceremonies, or any other event attended by the players.**

XIV. PLAYING FIELDS/FACILITIES -

(a) The playing fields must meet all DYB specifications in the official DYB Rule Book for World Series. Dugouts, sideline fencing, and a scoreboard must be provided. The Commissioner will approve all playing fields.

(b) All Division I games will be played at the **Susan B. Vincent Sportsplex & Elvin Ulmer Eightplex 4978 US-84, Laurel, MS 39443.**

(c) All Division II games will be played at the **Susan B. Vincent Sportsplex & Elvin Ulmer Eightplex 4978 US-84, Laurel, MS 39443.**

(d) **LAUREL** shall have sufficient staff on hand in the event of inclement weather.

(e) **LAUREL** will provide a comfortable room away from the public where umpires, the news media and series officials may relax.

(f) **LAUREL** will furnish a public-address system that will give complete audio coverage to every part of the stadium including service areas, any temporary seating or standing areas and all approach areas. A backup system must be immediately available.

(g) **LAUREL** will provide adequate facilities to accommodate a minimum of 200 spectators at each field. The Inspection Team will determine the adequacy by reviewing the layout of the fields, types of bleachers available and options for use of lawn chairs.

(h) **LAUREL** will provide public restrooms, and these must be near the fields and there must be adequate facilities to accommodate crowds of up to 1,000.

(i) **LAUREL** will provide ample parking space near the park, at no charge, for all in attendance with a reserved area for all team transportation and for World Series officials, national board members, and state directors near the fields.

(j) **LAUREL** will provide a first-aid station with a medical doctor, registered nurse, or other trained medical personnel on duty during all sessions. Provide a number for a doctor on call for emergencies for visiting participants and officials.

(k) **LAUREL** will provide a uniformed police officer at the playing facilities at any time games are being played.

XV. PRESS BOXES

(a) **LAUREL** will provide press box facilities for all fields large enough to accommodate the official scorer, public address announcer, webcast announcers, press representatives, radio and television personnel approved by the Commissioner. There must be a copier in each press box. The host shall provide pencils and electric pencil sharpener for scorers and lineup cards for the teams. These facilities will be available to working news media and others having official business there **ONLY**. Commissioner has authority to restrict access to the press box where space is limited and may require passes for entry to the press box. **LAUREL** will provide an on-field remote microphone for award presentations.

(b) **LAUREL** will provide **scorers** for each press box for all DYB Division II Majors, AAA, and "O"Zone World Series games and all 6U and 8U World Series games at the **Susan B. Vincent Sportsplex & Elvin Ulmer Eightplex 4978 US-84, Laurel, MS 39443.**

(c) **LAUREL** will provide **announcers and scoreboard operators** for each press box for all World Series games at the **Susan B. Vincent Sportsplex & Elvin Ulmer Eightplex 4978 US-84, Laurel, MS 39443.**

(d) **LAUREL** must have a designated person in each press box forty-five minutes prior to the first game played each day of the Series until all games are completed for the day. This person shall coordinate the quick resolution of any issues related to lighting, sound systems, electrical power, score board, state flags, restrooms, internet connectivity, copiers, press box supplies, and dugout phones, with the Commissioner and other **DYB** press box officials.

(e) **LAUREL** will furnish a public address system that will give complete audio coverage to every part of the stadium including service areas, any temporary seating or standing areas and all approach areas. Back-up systems must be immediately available at both the **Susan B. Vincent Sportsplex & Elvin Ulmer Eightplex 4978 US-84, Laurel, MS 39443.**

XVI. WORLD SERIES FORMAT/SCHEDULE

- (a) The **DYB** World Series games will begin with a pool play game for each participating team in a format approved by the Commissioner.
 - (b) All game times and field assignments will be coordinated with the Host and approved by the Commissioner.
- The World Series pool play schedule and double-elimination brackets for the DYB World Series shall be included in the World Series Program.
- (c) The Host shall post and update a bracket at each playing field for the respective Series.

XVII. DYB WORLD SERIES UMPIRES -

- (a) The Commissioner will appoint a **DYB** World Series Coordinator.
- (b) The **DYB** World Series Umpire Coordinator will schedule two-man crews for each scheduled World Series pool play game and each 6U World Series game.. Three-man crews will be used in bracket play for 8U,-12U games..
- (c) The Tournament Director will approve the crews assigned to umpire in the **DYB** World Series for each day.
- (d) Prior to beginning World Series play, all umpires assigned to the World Series must attend a scheduled orientation meeting with the Tournament Director and World Series Umpire Coordinator at a time and place established by the Tournament Director. Any umpire assigned to the World Series that does not attend this meeting will not be allowed to officiate in that World Series.
- (e) The Tournament Director will meet with the World Series Umpire Coordinator and the World Series umpires for a daily briefing at a time and place established by the Tournament Director.
- (f) **DYB** will furnish a base cap approved by the Commissioner to each **DYB** World Series umpire.
- (g) **LAUREL** will pay each DYB World Series umpire a minimum of **\$100.00** per game for AAA, Majors, and "O"Zone games.
- (h) **LAUREL** will pay each DYB World Series umpire a minimum of **\$60.00** per game for AA & A (8U & 6U) games.
- (i) **LAUREL** will provide an air-conditioned dressing room facility to accommodate the umpires.
- (j) **LAUREL** will provide water to all umpire crews between innings during games and will assign responsible adults to supervise this responsibility.

XVIII. MISCELLANEOUS

- (a) **LAUREL will** develop a contingency plan in case of power failure during scheduled games including maintenance personnel on the site to manage any problems quickly.
- (b) World Series "OFFICIAL BALLS" - The Commissioner will provide the official World Series Baseballs for use in all World Series games. **LAUREL** will make available, at its cost, approved Baseballs if additional Baseballs are necessary to complete the Series.
- (c) Each dugout should have a trash can. Each dugout will be cleaned, and the trash emptied between games. Each team will be allowed one team cooler for drinks per game.
- (d) Any driver of any moving vehicles used at the World Series (Golf carts, etc. included) will be **required** to have a driver's license.

XIX. INSURANCE

LAUREL agrees to meet the following minimum insurance requirements as evidenced by a certificate of insurance with effective expiration dates encompassing the tournament dates including set up and take down:

- (1) **Excess Accident** – **LAUREL** shall provide Excess Accident insurance coverage with a medical limit of a minimum of \$50,000. **LAUREL** must provide insurance coverage for all umpires, scorekeepers, employees, and volunteers who provide services to the World Series events.
- (2) **General Liability** – **LAUREL** shall provide a General Liability insurance policy with an "each occurrence" limit of a minimum of \$1,000,000 combined single limits for "bodily injury" and "property damage". Such policy shall not provide "claims made" coverage and shall not have an exclusion for lawsuits arising out of injuries to athletic participants. Such policy shall be endorsed and will name **DYB, Inc.** as an "additional insured" and shall be endorsed to provide "primary and noncontributory" coverage to **DYB, Inc.**

DYB, Inc. shall not name **LAUREL**, the facility owner, or any other related parties as additional insureds under the **DYB, Inc.** General Liability policy.

XX. OPERATIONAL CONTROL

As concerns the 2026 DYB World Series, **LAUREL** agrees that **DYB, Inc.** shall have no operational control or responsibility over the following:

- **Premises and Playing Facilities**-including, but not limited to, practice areas, playing fields including dugouts, batting cages and spectator areas, concession areas, player accommodations, and player or spectator entertainment areas whether on site or off site.
- **Activities**-including, but not limited to, activities within housing, player, or spectator entertainment on site or off site, outings, and travel to and from the above.
- **Actions**-including all actions (including inactions) or decisions initiated by the tournament host or by team volunteers or employees, including the selection of volunteers and tournament security.

DYB Inc. will have operational control and responsibility only to the extent of requiring that any violation of official rules and regulations shall be corrected in accordance with the official rules and regulations.

XXI. COMPLIANCE WITH LOCAL, STATE & FEDERAL LAW

LAUREL & DYB agree that each party will comply with all local, state, and federal laws.

XXII. DEFAULT PROVISIONS

(a) If **LAUREL** fails to make any payments required by section **VI(b)** herein or materially breaches any other material provision of this Agreement, **DYB** may cancel this Agreement and give written notice to terminate **LAUREL's** right to host the 2026 World Series.

(b) In the event of termination of this agreement, **DYB** agrees to refund any funds paid to **DYB** by **LAUREL**, excluding any late payment penalties, less \$2,500 to defray costs associated with **DYB** securing an alternative world series host site.
