

ORDER
DECLARE SALE OF LPD SURPLUS VEHICLES

WHEREAS, the City of Laurel Police Department has identified various vehicles that are no longer usable for municipal services and are currently not in service and

WHEREAS, § 21-17-1 of the Mississippi Code of 1972 Annotated authorizes the governing authority of any municipality to dispose of and destroy real property not used for municipal purposes through lease, or conveyance; and

WHEREAS, the Administration of the City of Laurel has determined that it will be prudent to dispose and destroy of said unused vehicles through auction, sale of scrap or destruction.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Laurel City Council that the vehicles listed, have been declared surplus and not useful for municipal services and are to be disposed of and destroyed.
