

ORDER
(Regarding the Re-Appointment of Ms. Jerlean Nobles to the Board of Commissioners of the South Mississippi Fair)

WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 3362 of the Mississippi Legislature which establishes the guidelines for the South Mississippi Fair Commission states that "...All...appointments shall be for a term of five (5) years or until a successor is appointed and qualifies, and any member so appointed may be reappointed without limitation"; and

WHEREAS, the term of Ms. Jerlean Nobles will expire on May 16, 2026; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that Ms. Nobles be re-appointed or that another person be appointed to replace her; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Nobles has expressed her desire to be re-appointed

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Laurel City Council that the nomination of Ms. Jerlean Nobles by Mayor Johnny Magee be confirmed and that Ms. Nobles be re-appointed for a five-year term as a Commissioner of the South Mississippi Fair Board with said term to commence on May 17, 2026 and expire on May 16, 2031.

Motion was made by Councilperson Scruggs seconded by Councilperson Allen, that the above and foregoing Order be adopted.
