

ORDER

(To Consider Authorizing Acceptance Of Non-Perishable Food Items And Cash Donations for the LPD Stuff-A-Truck Food Drive

WHEREAS, the Laurel Police Department has received donations of non-perishable food items along with cash donations in the amount of (\$895) eight hundred ninety-five dollars for the LPD Stuff-A-Truck Food Drive held at Walmart on July 25, 2026.

WHEREAS, the Laurel Police Department has also received a monetary donation from E.W. and Joyce Sanders in the amount of \$200.00; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Laurel City Council that the City of Laurel Police Department be allowed to accept non-perishable food items, cash donations of (\$895) and a \$200 check for the LPD Stuff-A-Truck Food Drive held at Walmart on July 24, 2026. The total cash donation of \$1,095.00 will be deposited into the Police Department's Donations account (001-000-109-6). No donations will be placed in the Police General Fund.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Finance Director be authorized to perform whatever budget transactions are necessary for implementation of the foregoing Order.
