

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED by the City Council of Laurel, Mississippi that Alaina Rowzee be and it is hereby granted a one-year special exception renewal, under the provisions of the City of Laurel Zoning Ordinance for same, including but not limited to the provision regarding annual application for extension of said special exception. Said special exception allows operation of a day care for children to be located on the property. Special exception is sought on property described as:

BRYANT SUB-DIV BLK A (City of Laurel/Jones County Parcel No. 119N-12-11-039.00 PPIN 8566. Also known as 1922 Pearl Street.)

Property is located in R-2, Medium Density Residential District, which does not permit requested use. Property is located in Ward 1.

Said request for a special exception was initially heard by the Planning Commission in a regularly scheduled meeting on June 13, 2024. Renewal of the special exception was heard by the Planning Commission in a regularly scheduled meeting on October 9, 2025 There being no opposition from any party, The Planning Commission hereby recommends to the Laurel City Council that this special exception be granted for one year, as it would not adversely affect the adjoining property owners, the public health, the public safety, or the general welfare of the community.

Motion was made by Councilperson Allen, seconded by Councilperson Thomas, that the foregoing Order be adopted.
