

**ORDER
TO ACCEPT BID FOR STREET SWEEPER**

WHEREAS, by an Order adopted at the meeting of the City Council for the City of Laurel, Mississippi, on December 02, 2025, bids were directed to be received, after publication as provided by Law, for new street sweeper; and

WHEREAS, two bids were received and publicly opened on January 08, 2026 in the City Clerk's Office. A bid from Ingram Equipment was received in the amount of \$328,925.00 **(Exhibit A)**. A bid from River City Hydraulics was received in the amount of \$325,000.00. **(Exhibit B)** The low bid was rejected due to the bid not being submitted on the required City of Laurel bid form. The bid from Ingram Equipment was found to meet all the advertised specifications and requirements and was determined to be the best bid.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, that the bid totaling three-hundred twenty-eight thousand nine hundred twenty-five dollars and zero cents, (\$328,925.00) from Ingram Equipment LLC for one (1) 2026 TYMCO 600 on 2027 Freightliner M2-106 with 7.3 cubic yard capacity, be accepted. See attached bid review exhibits A&B.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that a purchase order be issued for the street sweeper by the finance department and any budget adjustments be made by the finance director. Funds will come from the infrastructure modernization fund.

SO ORDERED this the 20th day of January, 2026. Motion was made by Councilperson Amos, and seconded by Councilperson Allen, for the adoption of the above and foregoing Order.
