

FINAL RESOLUTION GRANTING EXEMPTION UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF MISS.
CODE

SECTION 27-31-101, ET SEQ, AS AMENDED

The City of Laurel has considered this day the matter of granting exemption from ad valorem taxes, except school district taxes and particular specified levies set forth by Orders of the governing authorities, to

Howard Industries, Inc

The governing authority finds that this enterprise has submitted verification and documentation as to the authenticity and accuracy of the application in regard to the true value of the property to be exempted and the date of completion of said enterprise. The governing authority also finds that the property described in the application constitutes and industrial enterprise as described in Section 31-101, et seq, Miss. Code of 1972, As Amended.

The governing authority does hereby grant, subject to approval and certification of the Department of Revenue, ad valorem tax exemption to the above taxpayer described in the application, with a total true value of \$4,358,016.00.

Therefore, the Resolution to grant ad valorem tax exemption to the above-named enterprise is hereby approved by City of Laurel for a period of ten (10) years, as authorized by Section 27-31-101, et seq, Miss. Code of 1972, As Amended.
