

RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION GRANTING THE ADMINISTRATION AUTHORITY TO COMMIT THE REQUIRED MATCHING FUNDS FOR THE 2026 SAFE STREETS AND ROADS FOR ALL FUNDING APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the City of Laurel intends to submit an application for federal funding assistance through the United States Department of Transportation's FY26 Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Funding Program;

WHEREAS, the City of Laurel proposes to construct improvements to 10th Avenue from 11th Street to 5th Street with rehabilitation and overlay of the existing roadway, new sidewalks along the west and east side, crosswalks, landscaping, curb & gutter, and water & sewer improvements;

WHEREAS, this project is estimated to cost **\$2,820,000.00**, and the project is eligible to receive up to \$2,256,000.00 in federal funding assistance through the FY26 SS4A grant program;

WHEREAS, this project will require an estimated 20% match of **\$564,000.00** from non-federal funding sources;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Laurel, Mississippi that:

1. That Administration is authorized to commit the required non-federal matchings funds for the project described herein.
2. That Finance Director is authorized to make any budgetary transactions necessary for implementation of the foregoing Resolution.
