ORDER

IT IS ORDERED by the City Council of Laurel, Mississippi that Harriet L. Jones be and it is hereby granted a one-year special exception, under the provisions of the City of Laurel Zoning Ordinance for same, including but not limited to the provision regarding annual application for extension of said special exception. Said special exception allows operation of an event venue to be located on the property. Special exception is sought on property described as:

COTTON MILL ADD BLK 6 LOT 7 (City of Laurel/Jones County Parcel No. 119B-06-20-007.00 PPIN 8948. Also known as 204 N. 13th Ave.)

Property is located in C-1, Restricted Commercial District, which does not permit requested use. Property is located in Ward 6.
