RESOLUTION GRANTING THE ADMINISTRATION AUTHORITY TO AWARD CONSTRUCTION AND EXECUTE THE PROFESSIONAL CONSTRUCTION SERVICES SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT OF THE ARCO LANE BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Laurel proposes to construct a box culvert to replace the existing bridge on Arco Lane at the intersection of East 5th Street;

WHEREAS, the proposed improvements include the removal of the existing bridge, construction of a box culvert, grouted riprap channel stabilization, intersection improvements, and utility relocation;

WHEREAS, the City of Laurel was previously forced to close the Arco Lane Bridge crossing at Gardiner Creek due to structural deficiencies;

WHEREAS, the City of Laurel has entered into a contract with Neel-Schaffer for professional services for design for the proposed project;

WHEREAS, Neel-Schaffer has prepared plans and specifications for the project known as Arco Lane Bridge Replacement Project;

WHEREAS, bids were received on Wednesday, April 8th, 2026, with three companies submitting bids;

WHEREAS, Holliday Construction, LLC submitted the low bid of \$767,072.50 as shown on the attached bid tabulation;

WHEREAS, Neel-Schaffer has submitted a supplemental agreement to provide professional construction administration and resident project representation services in the amount of \$70,000 to the City of Laurel;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Laurel, Mississippi that:

1. The Administration is authorized to award construction of the Arco Lane Bridge Replacement Project to Holliday Construction, LLC in the amount of \$767,072.50.
2. The Administration is authorized to execute the supplemental agreement with Neel-Schaffer to provide professional construction administration and resident project representation services in the amount of \$70,000.

3. That Finance Director is authorized to make any budgetary transactions necessary for implementation of the foregoing resolution.
