

**ORDER TO PLACE EVIDENCE OF US CURRENCY
IN THE LAUREL POLICE DEPARTMENT GENERAL FUND**


THIS CAUSE, this day came on for hearing on the State's Motion ore tenus to Deposit Evidence of US Currency in the Laurel Police Department General Fund. The defendant pled guilty on August 1, 2023 to Burglary of Auto x6 and was sentenced to serve seven (7) years in the custody of MDOC, with five (5) years to serve in the full-time custody of the Mississippi Department of Corrections and the remaining time suspended on condition of the successful completion of two (2) years of Post-Release Supervision on all six counts to run concurrently with each other. The deadline for post-conviction relief has since passed, and the State moves to allow the Laurel Police Department to deposit \$181.00 in US Currency that was taken into evidence during the investigation of the crimes into the Laurel Police Department General Fund; and the Court grants this motion in reliance on information presented to it by the State.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED and ADJUDGED that the evidence in the above-referenced cause, \$181.00 in US Currency, is to be deposited into the Laurel Police Department General Fund.
