

ORDER

(Authorizing Acceptance of a Project at Gardiner Park by the 2024-2025
Provisional Class of the Junior Auxiliary of Laurel)

WHEREAS, the 2024-2025 Provisional Class of the Junior Auxiliary of Laurel has proposed donating to the City an Augmentative and Alternative Communication (AAC) board to be located at Gardiner Park; **and**

WHEREAS, the AAC Board enhances inclusivity for children and adults with communication disorders and disabilities. The board will serve as a way for those who struggle to communicate to be better able to enjoy their experience at the park. The board also includes a QR code so that families can take it on the go; and

WHEREAS, the Administration and the Laurel City Council now find that AAC Board project will be an enhancement to the City of Laurel

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Laurel City Council that the City gratefully accept the Augmentative and Alternative Communication Board, donated by the 2024-2025 Provisional Class of the Junior Auxiliary of Laurel, to be placed in Gardiner Park.
