

ORDER

(Regarding Ratification Of Emergency Order for Repair of Sewer Line on South 13th Avenue)

WHEREAS, Mayor Johnny Magee on October 1, 2025, in response to an email from Veolia (See **Exhibit A**) issued an emergency order (See **Exhibit B**) authorizing the emergency replacement of the sewer line on South 13th Avenue between Ferrell Street and Roberts Street; **and**

WHEREAS, failure to make necessary repairs immediately would have created a hazard to the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, §31-7-13(k) of the Mississippi Code of 1972 Annotated gives authority to the Mayor, acting as an agent of the City, to order the immediate remediation of circumstances which threaten the safety and welfare of the citizens of the city with ratification of said actions to be granted by the council at the next regularly scheduled meeting

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Laurel City Council that the Emergency Order issued by Mayor Johnny Magee on October 1, 2025 be ratified and that repair of the sewer line on South 13th Avenue between Ferrell Street and Roberts Street be authorized along with payment of all invoices associated with the repair. The estimated cost is one hundred thousand eight hundred thirty-two dollars (\$100,832.00). **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED**, that the finance director is authorized to take any budgetary actions necessary for implementation of the foregoing order.
