

**RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO ENGAGEMENT WITH WEISBROD MATTEIS

**WHEREAS**, Weisbrod Matteis & Copley has agreed to represent the City of Laurel in this matter; and

**WHEREAS**, said Engagement Agreement (attached hereto as Exhibit “A”) would allow Weisbrod Matteis & Copley to represent the City of Laurel for a 33% contingency fee basis; and

**WHEREAS**, the City finds that fee is reasonable and fair; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Laurel desires to enter into said Engagement Agreement;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by City Council that Mayor Johnny Magee is hereby authorized to enter into said Engagement Agreement with Weisbrod Matteis & Copley PLLC as attached hereto as Exhibit “A”.
