

ORDER

TO APPROVE TRAVEL FOR PARKS & RECREATION EMPLOYEES TO ATTEND THE 2025 DIAMOND YOUTH BASEBALL DIVISION I & DIVISION II WORLD SERIES HELD IN LEXINGTON, SC, JULY 30 – AUGUST 5, 2025.

WHERE AS, the Director, Elvin Ulmer; Recreation Superintendent, Tim Barksdale and Recreation Supervisor, Jason Arrington are requesting that the City of Laurel approve their travel to attend the 2025 Diamond Youth Baseball World Series held in Lexington, SC as required by agreement with Diamond Youth Baseball due to being the host city of the 2026 World Series. Lodging \$163.90. per night per person for 7 nights (+/- applicable taxes) \$3,441.90; Meals and incidental per diem \$74.00 for 8 days \$1776.00 for an approximate total of \$5218.00.

IT IS ORDERED by the Mayor and the City Council that the Parks & Recreation Director, Elvin Ulmer, Recreation Superintendent, Tim Barksdale and Recreation Supervisor, Jason Arrington be approved to attend the 2025 Diamond Youth Baseball World Series held in Lexington, SC; July 30 – August 6, 2025. All travel expenses incurred by the Parks & Recreation Department shall be paid from the Recreation Administration Department's Travel, Job Training Account (100-550-610.0).
