

RESOLUTION

(Regarding the Appointment of 2026 Voting Delegates for the City of Laurel During the 2026 Annual Conference of the Mississippi Municipal League)

WHEREAS, the Mississippi Municipal League amended the bylaws of the association to provide for a ballot election, to be conducted by the officers of the Mississippi Municipal Clerks and Collectors Association, to be held each year at the summer convention, to elect a second vice president and to vote on any proposed bylaws changes; and
