

ORDER
(Authorizing 4th Amendment to the Contract with H2O Innovation
Operation & Maintenance, LLC, for Public Works Services in the
City of Laurel)

WHEREAS, by City Council Order of July 6, 2021, the City entered a contract with H2O Innovation Operation & Maintenance, LLC, for the operation of the City's public works services, with Contract Amendment #1 approved on February 8, 2022 and Contract Amendments #2 and #3 approved on September 19, 2023 ; **and**

WHEREAS, the initial four-year term of the contract will expire on September 30, 2025 with a provision to extend the existing contract for two (2) one-year terms;

WHEREAS, the Administration seeks to extend the contract for one year effective October 1, 2025 and expiring September 30, 2026

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Laurel City Council that Mayor Johnny Magee is authorized to sign Amendment #4 (attached hereto as **Exhibit A**) to the contract with H2O Innovation Operation & Maintenance, for public works services in the City of Laurel. The contract will be effective October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026. **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED**, that the Finance Director is hereby authorized to do any and all acts to fulfill said contract and implement the forgoing order.
