Amendment to Plan of Operations for the Class II Rubbish Site located at Hillcrest Drive/Airport Drive, Laurel, Jones County, Mississippi.

The City of Laurel hereby amends its Plan of Operation for the Class II Rubbish Site (Permit R2-028) to incorporate Renewable Wood Solutions, LLC (RWS) process to incinerate our wood waste or yard waste.

The noted wastes are defined as follows:

- (a) "Wood waste" is defined as untreated wood including tree stumps, trees, tree limbs, bark and leaves.
- (b) "Yard waste" is defined as grass, grass clippings, bushes, shrubs, and clippings from bushes and shrubs. Yard waste comes from residential, commercial/retail, institutional, or industrial sources as part of maintaining yards or other private or public lands. Yard waste does not include construction, renovation, and demolition wastes.

The City of Laurel at its existing rubbish site at Hillcrest Dr/Airport Dr will stockpile authorized wood debris in a designated area of the rubbish site for a period not to exceed nine (9) months or one and half (1½) acres in size, whichever comes first. All stockpiled wood debris will be maintained in orderly windrows within the dedicated stockpile area. Three (3) windrows closely placed adjacent to each other will be separated from the next three (3) windrows by a space not less than 35 feet to ensure sufficient firebreak is available. The wood debris will be received by the rubbish site and placed in windrows that begin at the farthest edge of the dedicated stockpile area and proceed with subsequent truck loads placed end to end until each windrow is complete. The City of Laurel will document the beginning date and ending date of the stockpiled debris and document that 1½ acres of storage has not been exceeded. The attached site figure illustrates the area and placement of the wood debris. Upon getting close to nine (9) months or 1½ acres, the City of Laurel will contact RWS to schedule RWS to come onsite and incinerate the stockpiled wood debris.

RWS will provide a 10-day prior notification to the City of Laurel and the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) before locating equipment to the Rubbish Site. RWS's Air Curtain Incinerator will temporarily locate on our Class II Rubbish Site at Hillcrest Dr/Airport Dr in Laurel, Mississippi and be positioned so that it is at least 150 feet from any dwelling and from any light commercial building not owned by the City of Laurel.

RWS will utilize an Air Curtain Incinerator and RWS loading equipment for the reduction of the above listed waste materials. Upon completion of the incineration, RWS will manage the generated ash product by wetting the ash during removal, as necessary, to prevent it from becoming air borne.

RWS will store the cooled ash in roll-off containers, trailers, or other equivalent containers. The containers will be covered or tarped prior to and during transfer of the containers off-site.

RWS may store the covered containers onsite for up to 60 days. Prior to the end of the 60-day period, RWS will remove all containers and RWS equipment from the Rubbish Site.
