

## ORDER

IT IS ORDERED by the City Council of Laurel, Mississippi that La Tonya Watson be and it is hereby granted a one-year Special Exception, under the provisions of the City of Laurel Zoning Ordinance for same, including but not limited to the provision regarding annual application for extension of said Special Exception. Said Special Exception allows operation of a commercial kitchen to be located on the property. Special Exception is sought on property described as:

7-8-11 CHURCHTON ADD LOT 17 (City of Laurel/Jones County Parcel No. 1190-07-03-001.00 PPIN 8702. Also known as 1104 Queensburg Ave.)

Property is located in Ward 7, zoned R-2, Medium Density Residential District, which does not permit requested use.

Said request for a Special Exception was heard by the Planning Commission in a regularly scheduled meeting on May 14, 2026. There being no opposition from any party, The Planning Commission hereby recommends to the Laurel City Council that this Special Exception be granted for one year, as it would not adversely affect the adjoining property owners, the public health, the public safety, or the general welfare of the community.

Motion was made by Councilperson Allen, and seconded by Councilperson Thomas, that the foregoing Order be adopted.
