

FINAL RESOLUTION GRANTING EXEMPTION
FROM AD VALOREM TAXES

The City Council of Laurel this day considered the matter of granting exemption from ad valorem taxes, except school district taxes and “mandated municipal levies” to Laurel Machine & Foundry Machine Shop, by its Order dated June 18, 2024.

The governing authority finds that the Department of Revenue has certified that the applicant is eligible for exemption. The authority also finds that the property described in the application constitutes an industrial enterprise as described in Section 27-31-101, Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended.

This governing authority does hereby grant ad valorem tax exemption to the above taxpayer for a period of 10 years, beginning January, 2024, and expiring January, 2033 on the property described in the application with a total true value of **\$199,876.00**.

Therefore, the resolution to grant ad valorem tax exemption to the above named enterprise is hereby approved by City Council of Laurel for a period of 10 years as authorized by Section 27-31-101 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, on this the 16th day of July, 2024.
