

## ORDER

(Regarding the Ratification of an Emergency Order Authorizing Removal of an Obstruction in Water Well #6)

**WHEREAS**, Mayor Johnny Magee on October 25, 2024 , issued an emergency order (see Exhibit A) accepting a quote for and authorizing the removal of an obstruction in Water Well #6; and

**WHEREAS**, §31-7-13(k) of the Mississippi Code of 1972 Annotated gives authority to the Mayor, acting as an agent of the City to order the immediate remediation of circumstances which threaten the safety and well-being of the citizens of the city, with ratification of said actions to be granted by the council at the next regularly scheduled meeting; and

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** by the **Laurel City Council** that the Emergency Order issued by Johnny Magee on October 25, 2024, a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**, be ratified and that the quote from National Water Services in the amount of forty-five thousand seven hundred seventy dollars (\$45,770.00) for the removal of an obstruction from Water Well #6 be accepted and that said work be authorized. **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED**, that the Finance Director is authorized to take any action necessary for implementation of the foregoing order.

Motion was made by Councilperson Capers, seconded by Councilperson Carmichael, that the above and foregoing Order be adopted.
