

ORDER

WHEREAS, the term of Mrs. Ann Barrow on the Board of Trustees of the Laurel Municipal Separate School District will expire at midnight on March 2, 2018; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Ann Barrow must be re-appointed or another appointee must be nominated by the Mayor and confirmed by the Laurel City Council to replace her; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Ann Barrow has declared her desire not to be re-appointed; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Jeremy Adams, a local citizen whose vita is attached hereto as Exhibit A, has expressed his willingness to succeed Mrs. Barrow as a member of the Board of Trustees of the Laurel Municipal Separate School District; and

WHEREAS, a newly appointed school board member is required to attend a course for certification by the Mississippi School Board Association as a prerequisite to being fully installed as a Trustee of the Laurel Municipal Separate School District; and

WHEREAS, said certification course is offered quarterly and as such requires prior notice to the school district office of a new appointee

NOW THEREFORE, upon nomination by the Mayor and confirmation of the Laurel City Council, it is ordered that Mr. Jeremy Adams be, and he is hereby appointed as a Trustee of the Laurel Municipal Separate School District for a term of five years with said term commencing March 3, 2018, and expiring at midnight on March 3, 2023.
