

**ORDER  
TO ACCEPT BID ON FINANCING  
THE FIRE DEPARTMENT LADDER TRUCK.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Laurel received a bid on July 30, 2018 for the cost of financing the purchase price of the Fire Department ladder truck for 15 years. The City of Laurel received 3 bids. The bids were from:

Trustmark Bank in the amount of 3.13 percent and  
Bancorp South Bank in the amount of 3.84 percent for 72 months and  
The First, in the amount of 4.05 percent. (SEE ATTACHED BIDS)

**WHEREAS**, after reviewing said bids, the City of Laurel accepts the bid from Trustmark Bank in the amount of 3.13 percent for 15 years.
