

ORDER

(To Consider Authorizing Application to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security for a Grant Under Its 2018 Justice Assistance Program)

WHEREAS, the Laurel Police Department was learned of the availability of funds in an amount of up to ten thousand, eight hundred, twenty-six dollars (\$10,826.00) through a 2018 Justice Assistance Grant; and

WHEREAS, said grant does not require matching funds and is noncompetitive and non-restrictive; and

WHEREAS, the Laurel Police Department has identified many needs which can be satisfied with the proceeds from the aforementioned grant should it be awarded

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Laurel City Council that the Laurel Police Department be authorized to apply to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security for a grant under the Justice Assistance Program. **BE IT FURTHER ORDERED** that Mayor be authorized to sign all documents necessary for acceptance and implementation of said grant should it be awarded, **AND FURTHER**, that the Finance Director be authorized to perform whatever budget transactions are necessary for execution of the foregoing Order.
