

ORDER

(To Consider Ratifying Emergency Order Issued by Mayor Johnny Magee on August 23, 2018, Authorizing Travel of Two Officers of the Laurel Police Department to New Orleans, Louisiana, for Extradition of Prisoner Wanted for Murder in the City of Laurel)

WHEREAS, on August 23, 2018, Mayor Johnny Magee, in response to a memo from Laurel Police Department (See Exhibit A), issued an emergency order (See Exhibit B) authorizing travel of two Laurel Police Department officers to New Orleans, Louisiana, to transport a prisoner wanted for murder in the City of Laurel, and authorized the payment of expenses associated with said travel to be paid from the Police Department Travel fund (#001-200-610.0)

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Laurel City Council that the Emergency Order issued by Mayor Johnny Magee on August 23, 2018, be ratified in accordance with §31-7-13(k) of the Mississippi Code of 1972 Annotated **AND FURTHER** that all expenses associated with the travel to New Orleans, Louisiana, by two officers of the Laurel Police Department be paid from the Travel fund of the Police Department (001-200-610.0).

Motion was made by Councilperson T. Comegys, seconded by Councilperson Wheat, that the above and foregoing Order be adopted.
