WHEREAS, the Finance Office for the City of Laurel has compiled a list of the aforementioned equipment; and

WHEREAS, § 21-17-1 of the Mississippi Code of 1972 Annotated authorizes the governing authority of any municipality to dispose of real property not used for municipal purposes through sell, lease, or conveyance; and

WHEREAS, the Administration of the City of Laurel has determined that it will be prudent to dispose of said unused equipment through auction, sale of scrap or destruction.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Laurel City Council that the equipment be disposed of is on the attached Location Report.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Mayor Johnny Magee, acting on behalf of the City of Laurel, be authorized any and all documents necessary for implementation of the foregoing Order;

AND FURTHER that the Finance Director be authorized to perform whatever budget transaction are necessary for same.
