

## **ORDER**

(To Consider Authorizing The Return Of Unused Funds To Healthy Heroes' Initiative Grant through the Blue Cross Blue Shield Foundation)

**WHEREAS**, the Police Department received a Healthy Heroes Grant to construct improvements to the existing walking track, purchase weights and remodel the weight room at the Police Training Academy;

**WHEREAS**, plans and specifications for the running track went over budget and funds were utilized from the weight room project to complete the track.

**WHEREAS**, the track was completed just before the end of the grant and there was not enough time to start on the weight room.;

**WHEREAS**, per our grant guidelines on the Healthy Heroes' Initiative grant \$2,100 of unused funds will be returned to the Blue Cross Blue Shield of Mississippi Foundation.;

**WHEREAS**, the grant for the Weight Room will be resubmitted and start the project first of 2019.;

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED** by the City of Laurel, Mississippi that:

The Laurel Police Department be allowed to return unused grant funds to the Blue Cross Blue Shield Foundation in the amount of \$2,100.
