

**ORDER AMENDING AMOUNT OF EXEMPTION ON
CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT AD VALOREM TAX EXEMPTION
FOR IMPROVEMENTS AT 543 CENTRAL AVE.
OWNED BY SWEET SOMETHING BAKERY, LLC**

WHEREAS, Section 27-31-31 Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, authorizes municipalities to grant an exemption from ad valorem taxes, except school taxes and “mandated municipal levies”, for a period of not more than seven (7) years on the value of improvements or renovations to structures located within the municipalities central business district neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, The City of Laurel passed an order on June 19, 2018 giving Sweet Something Bakery, LLC a tax exemption for the improvements performed on property located at 543 Central Ave. in the amount of \$184,570.00 for a period of seven (7) years beginning January 1, 2019.

WHEREAS, the Jones County Tax Assessor’s office has reviewed the values of the above-named property and changed the values. The new values for this property being: Non-Exempt taxable=\$91,620.00, Total Value of building=\$386,270.00 and Exemption total=\$294,650.00.00.

THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED, that the order previously adopted on June 19, 2018 be amended to reflect the new values as assessed by the Jones County Assessor’s office.
