RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING GOALS FOR MINORITY AND WOMEN OWNED BUSINESS PARTICIPATION IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CDBG PROGRAM

WHEREAS, one of the requirements of the CDBG program is that the City establish goals for Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) and Woman Business Enterprise (WBE) participation in the implementation of their CDBG projects; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LAUREL CITY COUNCIL that the City of Laurel adopts the goal of 10% participation by MBE=s and 5% participation by WBE=s in the implementation of its CDBG projects.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE LAUREL CITY COUNCIL that the City will solicit at least two (2) proposals or bids from MBE/WBE companies for professional and construction services, as well as post the advertisements for said services on the State=s Contract Procurement Website, in order to attempt to meet the goals as established above.
