## **ORDINANCE**

The City Council took up for consideration the matter of a certain proposed change in the Laurel Code, Chapter 11, Housing and Property Maintenance, Article I, Division 1, specifically adding Section 11-15. Temporary Parking for the Resident Disabled, which will be established under Ordinance No. 1097-1987, and which when instituted procedures for property maintenance/parking, for residential upkeep/parking within the City of Laurel.

Whereupon motion was made by <u>Councilperson T. Comegys</u>, seconded by <u>Councilperson Capers</u>, for approval of the First reading of the following addition to the <u>Laurel Code</u>, <u>Chapter 11</u>, <u>Housing and Property Maintenance</u>, <u>Article I, Division 1</u>, specifically adding <u>Section 11-15</u>, which will be established under <u>Ordinance No. 1097-1987</u>, and which when instituted procedures for property maintenance/parking, for residential upkeep/parking within the City of Laurel.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Laurel that the Laurel Code as referenced above be and the same is hereby added as follows.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAUREL, MISSISSIPPI ADDING TO THE LAUREL CODE, CHAPTER 11, HOUSING AND PROPERTY MAINTENANCE, ARTICLE I, DIVISION 1, SPECIFICALLY SECTION 11-15, **TEMPORARY PARKING FOR THE RESIDENT DISABLED**, WHICH WILL BE ESTABLISHED UNDER ORDINANCE NO. 1097-1987, AND WHICH WHEN INSTITUTED PROCEDURES FOR PROPERTY MAINTENANCE/PARKING, FOR RESIDENTIAL UPKEEP/PARKING WITHIN THE CITY OF LAUREL.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL of the City of Laurel, Mississippi:

SECTION I. That the Laurel Code, Chapter 11, Housing and Property

Maintenance, Article I, Division 1, Section 11-15, Temporary Parking for the Resident

*Disabled*, be added as follows:

• Citizens or their caregivers shall contact the Inspection Department and request a non-fee permit to park on their grass when it is necessary to gain entrance to their residence for what presents as a temporary disability. Said permit shall be good for 30 days renewable once.

- Citizens or their caregivers with disabilities that are expected to last more than 60 days shall request a temporary parking permit to park on their grass for no more than 60 days while they make arrangements to install a ramp, sidewalk or expand their driveway with asphalt, concrete or gravel to accommodate getting as close as possible to their residential entrance.
- Citizens with disabilities who continue to park on their grass for more than 5 business days without obtaining a non-fee permit and/or making provisions to prevent killing the grass, water ponding and topsoil erosion shall be subject to Environmental Court Municipal Citations.

SECTION II. That upon its second reading, this Ordinance shall become effective one month from and after its passage.
