

RESOLUTION

Authorizing Mayor Johnny Magee, Acting on Behalf of the City of Laurel, to Enter a Contract with Schneider Electric for Replacement of Chiller at Laurel Police Department

WHEREAS, the air conditioning system at the Laurel Police Department is in poor working condition and requires frequent repairs and weekly maintenance to the existing chiller equipment; and

WHEREAS, it has become cost-prohibitive to the City's budget to continue to pay for recurring repairs and weekly maintenance of the existing chiller, and the City of Laurel now finds that it is in the best interest of the City and fiscally responsible to replace the existing chiller; and

WHEREAS, by Council order of April 4, 2017, Schneider Electric is under contract with the City to provide professional services for energy performance improvements which eliminates the need for seeking bids for the chiller replacement project; and

WHEREAS, the City must enter into a separate contract with Schneider Electric for the replacement of the LPD chiller with a turn-key project value of two-hundred eighty-six thousand forty-nine dollars (\$286,049.00). A copy of said contract is attached hereto as Exhibit A;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Laurel City Council authorizes Mayor Johnny Magee, acting on behalf of the City of Laurel, to execute a contract with Schneider Electric to replace the chiller at the Laurel Police Department for an amount of two-hundred eighty-six thousand forty-nine dollars (\$286,049.00). **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Finance Director be authorized to perform whatever budgetary transactions are necessary for implementation of the foregoing Resolution.

Motion was made by Councilperson Capers and seconded by Councilperson Wheat, for the adoption of the above and foregoing Resolution.
