

## **ORDER**

### **TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY TO ENTER INTO A ASPHALT OVERLAY CONTRACT WITH DUNN ROADBUILDERS FOR A SECTION ON FRONT STREET**

**WHEREAS**, the City has received two quotes to overlay asphalt, 1.5" SC-1, Front Street from the South Gate of Laurel Machine and Foundry to the Intersection of 7<sup>th</sup> Street. Approximate length is 500 lf. Approximate width is 20 lf. There is an existing abandoned railroad crossing that will be covered with asphalt. Any existing bolts that maybe a safety hazard to the traveling public should be removed prior to paving. However, the cross ties and rails are to remain in place; and

**WHEREAS**, Administration is now requesting permission to accept the lowest and best quote:

Dunn Roadbuilders	\$18,560.00
T. L. Wallace, Inc.	\$20,300.00

**THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED**, that the Adminstration enter into an asphalt overlay contract with Dunn Roadbuildings, the lowest and best quoter, for a section on Front Street.

**THEREFORE IT IS ALSO ORDERED**, that the Finance Director is given the authority to make all necessary budget amendments from the unappropriated fund balance within the General Fund.
