

ORDER

(To Consider Approving Application by the Laurel Police Department for Grant Funds from the Wal-Mart Foundation Community Equipment Outreach Program and Authorization of Mayor Johnny Magee to Sign Any and All Documents Necessary for Acceptance of Funds Should they be Awarded)

WHEREAS, the Laurel Police Department has learned of the availability of grant funds in an amount of up to five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) through the Wal-Mart Foundation Community Equipment Outreach Program; and.

WHEREAS, said funds are available through a non-competitive, non-match grant and will be used for community projects, police equipment and Relief supplies for the department; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Laurel City Council that the Laurel Police Department be authorized to apply to the Wal-Mart Foundation for grant funds in an amount of up to five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) through their Community Equipment Outreach Program. **BE IT FURTHER ORDERED** that Mayor Johnny Magee, acting on behalf of the City of Laurel, is authorized to sign all documents necessary for acceptance of funds and implementation of said project should the grant be awarded, **AND FURTHER**, that the Finance Director be authorized to perform whatever budget transactions are necessary for execution of the foregoing Order.
