

RESOLUTION

GRANTING AUTHORITY TO EXECUTE A UTILITY AGREEMENT WITH AT&T MISSISSIPPI FOR THE BEACON STREET CORRIDOR PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Laurel proposes to construct improvements along Beacon Street from Interstate 59 / Highway 84 / Highway 15 to the intersection of Central Avenue and 5th Street, known as the Beacon Street Corridor Project;

WHEREAS, the project is partially funded with a federal earmark;

WHEREAS, required matching local funds are being provided through local bonds;

WHEREAS, the project has been activated with the Mississippi Department of Transportation;

WHEREAS, the project requires that the existing overhead utilities, including telecommunication lines, be relocated at a total cost of \$427,800.00;

WHEREAS, the cost for re-locating the utilities is a shared cost between AT&T Mississippi and the City of Laurel;

WHEREAS, the City's portion of the cost is \$193,600.00 (45%) and is eligible for reimbursement through the federal earmark;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Laurel, Mississippi that:

1. That Administration is authorized to execute a Utility Agreement with Mississippi Power Company for the Beacon Street Corridor Improvements Project, Project Number IMD-8077-00(002) LPA/106639-820500 Jones County, Mississippi contingent upon approval and execution by AT&T Mississippi.
