

ORDER

**TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY CLERK
TO ISSUE WARRANTS FOR PARCEL #9A AND PARCEL #9D
RELATED TO THE LEONTYNE PRICE CORRIDOR PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the City of Laurel has entered into a contract with Neel-Schaffer Engineering Firm and is currently in the design phase of the Leontyne Price Corridor Project; and

WHEREAS, Neel-Schaffer has subcontracted with the law firm of Hortman, Harlow, Bassi, Robinson, & McDaniel, PLLC for obtaining the necessary property to complete this project; and

WHEREAS, the City has budgeted \$250,000.00 for right-of-way easements. This amount was included in the 2013 Street Improvement Bond and will be used as part of the City's match credit for the project; and

WHEREAS, in order to facilitate this project in a timely manner, Administration is asking the City Council to give the City Clerk/Finance Director the authority to issue warrants for property parcels #9A and #9D (See attachment).

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Laurel City Council that the City Clerk/Finance Director is authorized to issue warrants for the parcels #9A and #9D to the Jones County Circuit Clerk.
