## **Minority and Women Business Enterprises Policy Statement**

The City of Laurel, Mississippi does hereby resolve and will encourage the promotion and participation of Minority/Women Business Enterprises in every aspect of their Community Development Block Grant and HOME Investment Partnership Grant Program Projects. The Mayor and City Council do hereby adopt the following requirements as part of their MBE/WBE Goals: Public Law 95-507, Executive Order 11625, and Executive Order 12432(MBE, Executive Order 12138 WBE) and the Mississippi Minority Business Enterprise Act of 19888. The Board also proposed the flowing procedures and actions:

- 1. Utilize the current Mississippi Minority Directory and other available lists as the City's local MBE/WBE Directory.
- 2. Contact at least two (2) Minority/Women owned businesses by certified mail in an effort to solicit proposals or bids for CDBG and HOME Program activities.
- 3. Maintain records to document the extent of MBE/WBE contracting and sub-contracting. The City will submit semi-annual contract and subcontract activity reports to the Community Services Division of the Mississippi Development Authority and/or MS Home Corp. in a timely manner.
