## ORDER

## (Approving Updating the Inventory of Duty Handguns for the Laurel Police Department)

**WHEREAS**, the Laurel Police Department wishes to update its inventory of duty handguns and all related duty gear including duty holsters, magazine pouches, carry ammunition and other related equipment; and

**WHEREAS,** the Laurel Police Department seeks an inventory trade-in of 68 existing duty weapons for new Glock Night Sight firearms with ammunition and gear from Glock, Inc., Mid-South Uniform and Supply and Gulf State Distributors; (See Exhibit A); and

**WHEREAS**, the Laurel City Council now finds that it is in the best interest of the City of Laurel that the Laurel Police Department be allowed to make said update to its inventory of duty handguns;

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED** by the Laurel City Council that the Laurel Police Department be allowed to update its duty handgun inventory by trading in 68 existing duty weapons. This transaction requires an estimated budget amendment of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000), with funds being transferred from account #001-200-612.0 to account #001-200-539.0 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Finance Director be authorized to perform whatever budgetary transactions are necessary for implementation of the foregoing Order.
