ORDER

(To Consider an Increase in Funding for Laurel/Jones County Library)

WHEREAS, the Laurel Jones County Library has submitted to the City of Laurel a request for increased funding for the current FY2020; and

WHEREAS, the current budget allocation for the LJC Library is one hundred and five thousand dollars (\$105,000) annually or eight thousand seven hundred fifty dollars (\$8,750) monthly; and

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends an allocation of one hundred thirty-five thousand dollars (\$135,000) annually or eleven thousand two hundred fifty dollars (\$11,250) monthly, which reflects an increase of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) annually or two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) monthly; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned request from the LJC Library is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Laurel City Council that the City of Laurel amend its FY2020 budget to increase the contribution to the Laurel Jones County Library by thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000), bringing the annual allocation to one hundred and thirty-five thousand dollars (\$135,000) or eleven thousand two hundred fifty dollars (\$11,250) monthly. FURTHER, IT IS ORDERED that the Finance Director be authorized to perform whatever budget transactions as are necessary for the facilitation of this Order.

Motion was made by <u>Councilperson Capers</u>, seconded by <u>Councilperson Wheat</u>, that the above and foregoing Order be adopted.
