

ORDER
(Regarding the Sale of Various Unused Vehicles and
Equipment at Public Auction)

WHEREAS, various departments of the City of Laurel have identified vehicles and pieces of equipment that are no longer usable for municipal services; and

WHEREAS, the Safety Coordinator for the City of Laurel has compiled a list of the aforementioned vehicles and equipment, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, 21-17-1 of the Mississippi Code of 1972 Annotated authorizes the governing authority of any municipality to dispose of real property no longer used for municipal purposes through sale, lease, or conveyance; and

WHEREAS, the Administration of the City of Laurel has determined that it will be prudent to dispose of said unused vehicles and equipment through sale at public auction and public auction will be conducted by Johnny Wright Auctions, LLC, see Exhibit B;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Laurel City Council that the following vehicles and equipment be offered for sale at public auction; **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Mayor Johnny Magee, acting on behalf of the City of Laurel, be authorized to sign any and all documents necessary for implementation of the foregoing Order; **AND FURTHER** that the Finance Director be authorized to perform whatever budgetary transactions are necessary for same.
