It is agreed and understood that this bond shall be in full force and effect indefinitely and that a continuation or renewal certificate is unnecessary.



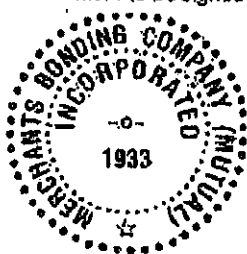

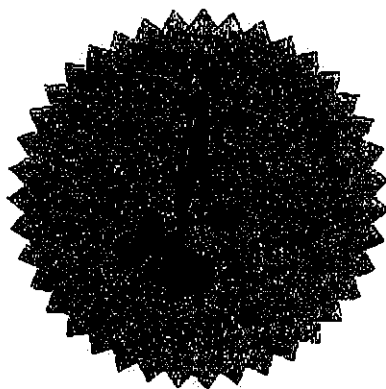
