## **ORDINANCE NO. 1695-2020**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. #1415-2002, #1497-2007, #1527-2008, #1542-2009, #1569-2010, #1583-2011, #1595-2012, #1603-2013, #1616-2014, #1624-2016, #1655-2017, #1676-2018, AND #1686-2019 FROM CHAPTER 25, "WATER", OF THE LAUREL CODE OF ORDINANCES PERTAINING TO ARTICLE IV. "RATES AND CHARGES", SECTION 25-53: WATER RATES

**WHEREAS,** the Administration and City Council of the City of Laurel, Mississippi have previously adopted ordinances establishing the rates for the water services for the City of Laurel; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Laurel recommends a 3% increase in the water rates beginning May 1, 2020.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and City Council that the City of Laurel Code of Ordinances Chapter 25, "Water", Article IV. "Rates and Charges", Section 25-53: Water Rate Schedule be amended as follows:

PRESENTLY, this Section now states:

Section 25-53. Water Rate Schedule.

# WATER RATE SCHEDULE

### Residential Customers:

<u>Inside City Rate</u> - minimum charge of \$12.83 for 3,000 gallons or any part thereof plus Three Dollars and twenty-two cents per thousand gallons used beyond the first 3,000 gallons (\$3.22/1,000)

Outside City Rate – minimum charge of \$19.29 for 3,000 gallons or any part thereof plus Four Dollars and eighty-one cents per thousand gallons used beyond the first 3,000 gallons (\$4.81/1,000)

### **Commercial Customers:**

<u>Inside City Rate</u> - minimum charge of \$19.29 for 3,000 gallons or any part thereof plus Three Dollars and twenty-two cents per thousand gallons used beyond the first 3,000 gallons (\$3.22/1,000)

Outside City Rate – minimum charge of \$28.92 for 3,000 gallons or any part thereof plus Four Dollars and eighty-one cents per thousand gallons used beyond the first 3,000 gallons (\$4.81/1,000)

#### **Industrial Customers:**

Will be charged a combined water/sewer rate of Three Dollars and ninety-one cents per thousand gallons used (\$3.91/1,000)

To qualify for Industrial rates, the customer shall average five million (5,000,000) or more gallons/month for twelve (12) consecutive months immediately preceding the following month's City of Laurel Water Department billing cycle.

Bulk Water Sales: All bulk water sales from Water Plant #2 shall be charged Four Dollars and ninety-nine cents per thousand gallons (\$4.99/1,000)

THE REVISED section in bold lettering would now read as follows:

## WATER RATE SCHEDULE

## **Residential Customers:**

<u>Inside City Rate</u> - minimum charge of \$13.21 for 3,000 gallons or any part thereof plus Three Dollars and thirty-two cents per thousand gallons used beyond the first 3,000 gallons (\$3.32/1,000)

Outside City Rate – minimum charge of \$19.87 for 3,000 gallons or any part thereof plus Four Dollars and ninety-five cents per thousand gallons used beyond the first 3,000 gallons (\$4.95/1,000)

## **Commercial Customers:**

<u>Inside City Rate</u> - minimum charge of \$19.87 for 3,000 gallons or any part thereof plus Three Dollars and thirty-two cents per thousand gallons used beyond the first 3,000 gallons (\$3.32/1,000)

<u>Outside City Rate</u> – minimum charge of \$29.79 for 3,000 gallons or any part thereof plus Four Dollars and ninety-five cents per thousand gallons used beyond the first 3,000 gallons (\$4.95/1,000)

#### **Industrial Customers:**

Will be charged a combined water/sewer rate of Four Dollars and three cents per thousand gallons used (\$4.03/1,000)

To qualify for Industrial rates, the customer shall average five million (5,000,000) or more gallons/month for twelve (12) consecutive months immediately preceding the following month's City of Laurel Water Department billing cycle.

Bulk Water Sales: All bulk water sales from Water Plant #2 shall be charged Five Dollars and fourteen cents per thousand gallons (\$5.14/1,000)

That upon its second reading, this Ordinance shall become effective on May 1, 2020 to ensure that the public utility fund can remain adequately funded.

Wheat, seconded by <u>Councilperson Page</u>, for the adoption and approval of the Second Reading of said Ordinance at this regular meeting of the City Council.
