

RESOLUTION

(Authority to Designate Agents for FEMA Disaster Assistance Funds Relating to the Iris Drive Bridge Replacement Project)

WHEREAS, by resolution of the Laurel City Council on August 18, 2020, the City of Laurel authorized acceptance of disaster relief funds from the Federal Emergency Management Agency and designated certain persons to act as agents authorized to sign documents related to FEMA Disaster #4415-DR-MS; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned FEMA disaster funds will be used to assist in the replacement of Iris Drive Bridge, which failed due to erosion from a severe storm event on December 27, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned resolution designated then-Public Works Director Ted Collins as the applicant agent and Mayor Johnny Magee as the Certifying Official for the FEMA Disaster #4415-DR-MS; and

WHEREAS, Ted Collins resigned September 18, 2020, and a new applicant agent must be designated for the City of Laurel for all future documentation related to this funding source (See Exhibit A)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Laurel City Council that City Clerk/Finance Director Mary Ann Hess is designated as the applicant agent on all documents relating to the FEMA/MEMA funding disaster #4415 DR-MS
